The role will report directly to the Operations Manager and will require knowledge of manufacturing processes.

Candidates should be technical and intimately familiar with the overall manufacturing process, have good attention to detail; problem solving and an understanding how each piece of machinery contributes to the overall process.

Duties and Responsibilities Include:
